Reporting Americanism is easy: fill out the VFW of Illinois on line Reporting Form or if you don't have a computer then you may contact State Headquarters (217-529-6688) to request the form and fill it in and mail it back to State Headquarters, P.O. Box 13206, Springfield, IL 62791-3206. Remember reporting dates are May 1, 2021 through April 30, 2022.

There are three (3) categories to report: Be sure to report all hours, money spent, and number of members participating in an event. You should report every time you have an event. The more you report the better chance you have of winning awards.

#### "Loyalty Day May 1, 2021"

Loyalty Day or May Day is always May 1.

A truly inspired Holiday, Loyalty Day was created by the VFW Organization in 1921. It was through the efforts of the Veterans of Foreign Wars that in 1958 Loyalty Day was officially established by an act of Congress.

The reason we have Loyalty Day is to continually encourage loyal Americans to speak out. It is a Day upon which patriotic citizens should:

- 1) Hold parades
- 2) Conduct Flag ceremonies
- 3) Sponsor public meetings
- 4) Conduct school programs
- 5) and other American activities

Loyalty is an intangible thing, but it causes people to form a Government, to obey its laws and rules and to willingly defend their country against its enemies.

If your Post does not hold a Loyalty Day parade, maybe your District will

- 1) Invite civic leaders to participate and to speak
- 2) Encourage neighborhoods to join in
- 3) Invite the youth to march, or play in bands
- 4) Give out flags
- 5) Hold your VFW Buddy Poppy Donation Day



#### Smart/Maher VFW National Citizenship Education Teacher Award

(Please note Deadlines)

This Program recognizes teachers who care about America. VFW annually recognizes the Nation's top classroom Elementary, Junior High (Middle Schools) and High School teachers who teach Citizenship Education topics regularly and who promote American History, traditions and institutions. Nominations are submitted by fellow teachers, supervisors and other interested individuals (not relatives). **Self-nominees are not eligible.** 

National Headquarters mails these brochures out directly to the Schools but......**Posts still need to con**tact the schools regarding this Program.

Posts will need to follow up as **<u>deadlines</u>** are as follows:

- Teacher Nominations to Post October 31, 2021
- Completion of Post Judging November 15, 2021
- Completion of District Judging December 15, 2021
- Completion of Department Judging January 10, 2022
- Department winners to National January 15, 2022
- District participation reports due to Department Chairman January 1, 2022
- Department Reports to National January 31, 2022

District Chairmen **must** send the following to Department Headquarters for Judging:

Winner's original entry form and essay of 350 words or less

Winner's official Post Teacher Entry form with signatures at **Post & District** Level.

One page resume (no more than two sides)

Up to 5 (five) pages (both sides) of additional documentation (i.e. news articles, supervisor's recommendations.)

Good quality head and shoulders photograph (color copies or low grade computer printouts will not be accepted)

#### (Note: No entries will be considered for Department Judging if all of the above criteria is not included with the nomination)

State Awards

The first place winner in each of the three categories will receive \$100.00 Cash and a special engraved plaque. A special engraved plaque will also be presented to the winning Teacher's School.

The Categories are:

Kindergarten through 5<sup>th</sup> Grade, 6<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> Grade, and 9<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> Grade. National Awards (as shown on our National Headquarters web page, www.vfw.org.)

## Included in this Program is the end of the year Post Report Form that the District Chairman is to fill out and submit to the State Americanism Program Director by no later than January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022.

#### Local Teacher Could Be Honored With National VFW Award

Every year, the VFW recognizes three exceptional teachers for their outstanding commitment to teaching Americanism and patriotism to their students. The three winning teachers receive \$1,000 for their professional development, \$1,000 for their school plus an all-expenses-paid trip to the VFW's National Convention in July.

Teachers of grades K-5, 6-8 and 9-12 can be nominated by fellow teachers, students, supervisors or other interested individuals. Teachers who promote civic responsibility, flag etiquette and patriotism, and strive to help students develop a better understanding of democratic values and beliefs are prime candidates for the award. Nomination forms are due to your local VFW Post by October 31.

Nominated teachers compete at the local VFW Post level with the winners advancing to District. District winners compete in the state level competition with state first-place winners advancing to the National Competition.

The VFW enacted the Teacher of the Year award contest in 1999 as a way to identify and recognize America's best educators. The VFW annually recognizes the nation's top teachers who instill a sense of national pride in students by teaching citizenship education topics regularly and promoting America's history and traditions effectively.

### SMART/MAHER VFW NATIONAL CITIZENSHIP EDUCATION TEACHER AWARD CITATIONS FOR ELEMENTARY, MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL TEACHERS AND THEIR SCHOOLS

Each year, the Veterans of Foreign Wars selects elementary, middle and high school teachers to participate in the Smart/Maher VFW National Citizenship Education Teacher program. Effective this year, VFW Post Teacher Award Chairman may submit a candidate to their **Department Headquarters by January 1** in each category. The Department may select a single candidate for each of the three awards and submit those to **VFWNational Headquarters by February 1**. VFW's Department Teacher winners that are received at National Headquarters will receive a VFW National citation for both the winning teacher and their school in each grade category.

NOTE: The only item the National VFW Programs Department requires is the "VFW Department Teacher Award Citation Request Form" which is now available on the VFW website. Simply visit vfw.org/#login, log in to My VFW, then look under Member Resources, click on VFW Training & Support, then click on Community Service & Youth Programs, then look under Additional Resources. The Teacher Entry form, Instruction sheet, Citation Request form and Chairman's manual will be up on the VFW website in the near future.

#### Who Is Eligible?

- 1. Teachers who promote civic responsibility, flag etiquette and patriotism are prime candidates for this award. For example, do you know a teacher who plans field trips to city hall or organizes community volunteer projects? Maybe you know an instructor who invites veterans into the classroom to discuss their military experiences. Perhaps you are familiar with a teacher who fosters the development of democratic values and beliefs through special projects. If you know of such a teacher, honor him or her today.
- **2.** All current certified/licensed teachers in grades K-12 are eligible. Previous national winners are ineligible. Nominations can be submitted by themselves, fellow teachers, supervisors, family members or other interested individuals.

#### Documentation required for all Candidates:

1. All Post-level nominees should provide a one-page resume as a minimum or up to five pages as a maximum of documentation of their teaching experience (for example: references, news articles, etc.) and a head-and-shoulder photo of themselves. These items will be forwarded on to the Department with the winning Teacher Entry form.
