### STATE HEADQUARTERS HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

State Headquarters will be closed on the following days: December 25<sup>th</sup> and December 26<sup>th</sup> for Christmas, December 31<sup>st</sup>, the office will close at 12:00 pm, and January 1st, New Year's Day.

### PROCEDURE FOR SUBMITTING AUDIT REPORTS

Quarterly audits must bear the signatures of the Commander and three Trustees. Audits can be submitted by fax, mail, or email to State Headquarters (admin@vfwil.org). If you are behind in your audits and need assistance, please either contact your District Commander or State Headquarters.

### **QUARTERLY REPORT OF AUDIT**

**Section 218, 11, b Trustees:** Within thirty (30) days from the end of each quarter, properly audit the books and records of the Post Quartermaster, Post Adjutant, and any activity, club room, holding company or unit sponsored, conducted or operated by, for or on behalf of the Post and submit a Post Trustee's Report of Audit to the Department Quartermaster for referral to the Department Inspector.

**Section 218**, **a**, **1**, **j Commander**: Assure that the Post Trustees have examined the books and records of the Post and prepared the Post Trustees Quarterly Report of Audit no later than the end of the month following the last day of each quarterly period.

Posts that have Audit's delinquent are subject to suspension by the State Commander.

### PEARL HARBOR DAY - SUNDAY, DECEMBER 7, 2025

Since Public Law 103-308 was passed in 1994, December 7th is designated as National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day. It requests that the American Flag be flown at half-staff from sunrise to sunset in honor of the individuals who lost their lives on December 7, 1941. You can find a Pearl Harbor Day Speech on the National VFW website. After logging in, it can be found under Patriotic Holiday Speeches.

### **TEACHER OF THE YEAR AND PUBLIC SAFETY AWARDS**

The Commander's Leadership Manual outlines the requirements for the Teacher of the Year and Public Safety Awards. The Public Safety Awards include the following five categories: Law Enforcement, Firefighter, EMT/Paramedic, Emergency Dispatcher, and Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) Technician.

For a Post and District to achieve All-State status, it must submit a Teacher of the Year or a Public Safety Award nomination. The submission deadlines are:

### **Eligibility Requirements**

- Age: The applicant must be under 18 years old and must have reached their 15th birthday at the time of application submission.
- Scout Affiliation: The applicant must be an active member of one of the following organizations:
- Scouting America (Eagle Scout)
- Girl Scouts of the USA (Gold Award Recipient)
- Venturing (Summit Award Recipient)
- Sea Scouts (Quartermaster Award Recipient)
- Good Standing: The applicant must be in good standing with their scouting unit and organization.
- Completion of Award: The highest award (Eagle Scout, Gold Award, etc.) must have been achieved prior to the application deadline.

### **Application Requirements**

- **Photograph of the Scout** must be attached to this form. The Scout must appear in correct, complete uniform for their current rank. Recommended size 3" x 5".
- School Participation Record <u>a single page</u>, one-sided resume of the candidate's school activities indicating <u>academic achievements</u>, <u>offices held</u>, <u>honors received and significant participation in other activities</u>.
- Scouting Record maximum of three pages, one side only, listing of all: Scouting participation beginning with Cub Scouts or Brownies years of participation, unit numbers and sponsors. Also include when Eagle, Gold, Summit or Quartermaster Award was received and Palms. Identify leadership positions held at all levels, participation in Scouting activities (jamborees, Order of the Arrow conferences, etc.) and the candidate's Eagle Scout, Girl Scout Gold Award, Venture Summit or Sea Scout Quartermaster Project.
- Community Service Record <u>a single page</u>, one -sided resume listing participation in community and religious service organizations (excluding Scouting and school), <u>noting</u> leadership positions held and any recognition received.
- Letters of Recommendation Submit three letters, no more than two pages in length from: A scout leader. A community member. A teacher/faculty member (if homeschooled, a parent letter is allowed). In addition, you may include one or two additional letters, no more than two pages in length, from local community members who have special knowledge of the candidate's abilities/accomplishments.
- Completed Entry Form submitted to a local VFW Post.


