STATE HEADQUARTERS CLOSURE

State Headquarters will be closed on June 4th through June 8th for the State Convention and on June 19th in observance of Juneteenth.

DEPARTMENT ELECTED/APPOINTED OFFICERS AND DISTRICT JUNIOR VICE COMMANDERS

All newly elected and appointed Department Officers and District Junior Vice Commanders for the 2025-2026 term of office are reminded that, according to our National Bylaws, all Officers listed above are required to submit proof of eligibility to the Department Adjutant before being installed into their respective offices during the State Convention. If you have a question on whether or not you have ever submitted your DD-214 or Proof of Eligibility to the Department, please contact the State Adjutant before the convening of the State Convention in June.

PROOF OF ELIGIBILITY REQUIRED FOR ALL ELECTED AND APPOINTED OFFICERS

Officers shall not be installed or assume the duties of their office until proof of eligibility has been submitted and adequately reviewed. Proof of eligibility shall be open to and reviewed by the District Commander, Adjutant, and Quartermaster before installation in office. In the event an elected or appointed officer fails to submit proof of eligibility within thirty (30) days of election or appointment, any right of the officer to hold the office shall be forfeited, the office declared vacant, and the eligibility qualifications of such officer shall be questioned following the provisions of Section 108 of the National By-Laws. Proof of Eligibility for

District Commanders, District Senior Vice Commanders, and District Junior Vice Commanders MUST be furnished to the State Adjutant within thirty (30) days of the Election.

STATE CONVENTION SPECIAL ANNOUNCMENTS

There will be a Shuttle from Timi's Tours that will run between the Crowne Plaza and the BOS center for those staying at the Crowne Plaza. The bus will pick up at the Crowne Plaza and drop off at the BOS Center. A sign will be attached to the window, and the pickup/drop-off location will be on the north side of the BOS lobby, located on Washington Street, between 7th and 9th streets. There is an area marked 'Pick Up and Drop Off'. A shuttle bus schedule is attached, and it can also be found on the state website at www.vfwil.org under "News." Finally, since the Wyndham is not open for business, parking in the parking garage will be free.

STATE CONVENTION REGISTRATION

Included in these General Orders is the Advance Registration Form for the State Convention. Delegates can also register online by visiting www.vfwil.org. The registration fee is now \$22.00 per member. Letters of registration confirmation will be mailed to registrants after the proper registration fee has been paid. Registrants will be required to present this confirmation when they check in at the convention registration desk at the BOS Center. Reminder: Delegates will not be allowed to vote until these issues have been

resolved, specifically if the Post is in arrears for supplies, poppies, or any other financial obligation to the Department. The Post must be bonded, have an inspection approved by the State Inspector, and have an election report on file with the Department and National Headquarters for the ensuing year. Additionally, all audits, including the March 31, 2025, audit, must be submitted and approved. The delegate strength to the convention is based on one delegate and one alternative delegate per thirty members or a fraction thereof. Registration will be open in B 11 A/B of the BOS Center:

HOSPITALITY ROOM

The joint hospitality room will be in the Freeport Room and the Governor Yates Room on the 2nd Floor of the Presidential Abraham Lincoln Hotel, 701 E. Adams St., Springfield, IL. According to the City Fire Code and the hotel rules, there can be NO heating devices or heating elements in the hospitality room. This includes electric hot plates, crockpots, and roasters, but excludes anything that uses gas or propane. You can use a hot box or an insulated container to keep hot foods warm but avoid anything that requires a power source to maintain the temperature. Also, this year, the hospitality room will be closed during all the business sessions, the Memorial Service, and the Patriotic Rally.

Program Bulletin VOD June 2025

As you probably know Scholars App, is a company that has been contracted by the National VFW Programs Staff to help offer the PP/VOD Contests to eligible students nationwide. Scholars App helps students complete their digital entries which are submitted to participating posts. The post then judges the entries and advances their post winning student entry(s) to district. District, in turn utilizes the same process to judge and advance their winner to department. The department and national do the same. The Scholars App program also provides for efficient reporting of these contests at all levels which has been a long- standing issue.

Last year National VFW mandated that Scholars App reporting be introduced at the district level, which was poorly communicated by national and department personnel alike, and required district chairpersons to backtrack operations that should have been completed at the post level which caused considerable confusion. This year we will be implementing the Scholars App program at the post level as it was designed.

The III. youth scholarship team has developed and continues to develop easy to follow instructions for post and district chairpersons to conduct their Patriot's Pen and Voice of Democracy contests utilizing Scholars App. These training aids will be readily available at the Department website soon. For those attending the convention this year we are offering a one-hour Breakout session outlining the Scholars App program and addressing questions for all who care to attend on Friday at 10:30-11:30.
