General Orders No. 10
April 2021

SECTION 213: ARREARAGES, DEFICIENCIES AND OMISSIONS

Any Post in arrears for any financial obligations to County Council, (if applicable), District,
Department and National for fees, dues, poppy money, failing to have the office of the
Quartermaster properly bonded in accordance with Section 709, failing to submit properly
completed quarterly Post Trustees Reports of Audit, Post Election Report for the ensuing year, or
other obligations, shall be deprived of all representation in County Council and District meetings;
County Council, District, Department and National Conventions. Such representation shall be
restored promptly upon proper adjustment of such deficiencies.

NOMINATIONS FOR VFW MEMBER OF THE YEAR

<u>District Commanders are reminded</u> that they are to submit their nominee for VFW Member of the Year to Junior Past State Commander Brad Gould, 1421 Gleason Dr., Rantoul, Illinois 61866. There is no special form to submit with your nominee for this award. However, we will need the nominee's name, address, and telephone number for notification purposes.

Please submit the information along with a written statement explaining why you feel your nominee is deserving of this recognition prior to <u>Friday, April 16 2021</u>. This award will be presented during the 100th Annual State Convention in Springfield, Illinois.

DEPARTMENT CONVENTION

IMPORTANT - REPORT OF ELECTION FORM

National Headquarters has mailed all Post Quartermasters a packet which includes the *2021-2022 Report of Election Form* with instructions on how to submit their report online using the Online Membership System (OMS). A blank Post Election Report can also be found in the "Document Repository" section on the Online Membership System. Post Quartermasters having difficulty submitting their election report can call VFW State Headquarters for assistance, (217) 529-6688. Included in this packet is information on how to register your Post for the National Convention along with a room reservation form for the National Convention. The 122nd VFW National Convention will be held July 31- August 5, 2021 in Baltimore, Maryland.

POLITICS

Your attention is directed to Section 702 of the National By-Laws regarding Politics:

"No officer or member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States shall in any manner use the Veterans of Foreign Wars for partisan politics and no discussion of partisan questions shall be permitted at any meetings nor shall any nominations, recommendations or endorsements for political office be made, provided this shall not apply to discussion of policies of any organization that seeks to alter our present form of government by force, violence or other unlawful means.

Participation in activities supporting or opposing legislation or administration of laws for veteran's welfare or relating to other matters pertaining to the purposes of the organization shall be permitted. Such participation shall be consistent with the legislative and welfare programs and policies approved by the National Convention.

No Post, County Council, District or Department shall participate in a labor dispute, either on behalf of labor or management. No member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States shall wear the VFW uniform or VFW cap in any plant or picket line or meeting of employees where a labor dispute arises.

Nothing contained in this Section shall prevent the organization of a lawful political action committee to further the purposes of the VFW as set forth in Section 230102 of the Congressional Charter, nor prevent any discussion of the activities of such a committee."

NOMINATIONS FOR AWARDS AND CITATIONS

The deadline for award nominations for our State Convention is <u>April 30, 2021</u> for the following categories: Outstanding Legislator of the Year, Humanitarian of the Year, Law Enforcement Officer of the Year, Firefighter of the Year, Paramedic of the Year, Outstanding Patriotism of the Year, Outstanding Governmental Service of the Year, Clergy of the Year, News Media Professional of the Year, and Outstanding Citizen of the Year.

There is no special form to fill out to nominate an individual. All you would need is the name of the individual, their address, the sponsoring Post and/or Auxiliary, the contact person for the nomination, and why this individual deserves to be recognized.

STATE CONVENTION AD BOOK

The form for the Convention Program Ad Book is on the homepage of our website: www.vfwil.org . Please print out the form, complete your ad and mail it to State Headquarters with your check. Note that the deadline for receiving your ad is April 30, 2021!

STATE AWARD PRESENTATIONS

Awards will be presented at the time the Program Director makes their final report during the State Convention. Directors must insure their awards are in the stage area prior to making their reports. *Please see agenda for Friday and Saturday for timeframe of when reports will be given.*

ATTENTION POST COMMANDERS

Under the Department of Illinois Veterans of Foreign Wars By-Laws, Article V - Convention, Section 8 - Registration at Annual Department Convention:

"Each Post shall register, in advance or at the Convention, at least one delegate to the Department Convention by payment of the advance registration fee in effect for such Convention, which fee shall entitle the Post to a packet of convention information and materials. Posts failing to comply with this requirement shall be considered delinquent and in arrears."

X-sheet program compliance reporting year end is April 30, 2021. Only 30 days to get your x-sheet items complete. Reminder: You must be 100% on the x-sheet to qualify for All-State status.

ELECTION OF POST DELEGATES

CONGRESSIONAL CHARTER, BY-LAWS, MANUAL OF PROCEDURE AND RITUAL

Article II - Posts, Section 217

Nomination, Election, Installation and Term of Office of Post Officers

Post officers shall be elected in April. Balloting for Post Officers may be conducted by open vote or written secret ballot (handwritten or printed) at a regular Post meeting, or, if required by Post By-Laws or authorized by Post vote prior to the opening of nominations, by a poll system. Absentee ballots and proxy votes are prohibited. A majority vote of all votes cast, except where otherwise designated, shall be necessary to elect. If there be not election on the first ballot, the name of the comrade receiving the lowest number of votes shall be dropped and so on in successive ballots until an election is made.

Article II - Posts, Section 222

Delegates, District Conventions & Meetings, Department and National Conventions

Delegates and alternates for the District Convention and Meetings, Department and National Conventions shall be elected at a regular meeting in **April**. Delegate strength will be based on members in good standing as of March 31st.

Delegates shall not be recognized at the National Convention unless they personally register their completed delegate card with the National Credentials Committee. Posts instituted after strength has been determined, but prior to convening date of the respective convention or district meeting, shall on the day of institution, elect one delegate and one alternate for each thirty names or fraction thereof according to the number of names listed on the charter application.

OUARTERMASTER BOND REQUIREMENT

The books and records of the Quartermaster, and other accountable officers, must be submitted at least quarterly by the Post Trustees. Failure on the part of the Commander to strictly enforce Section 218 of the National Manual of Procedure may release the Bonding Company of all liability in case of a defalcation. National By-Laws require Posts to have a Relief Fund. Any Audit submitted that does not show an active Relief Fund will not be accepted and will be returned. AUDITS MUST BE SIGNED BY THE THREE POST TRUSTEES AND THE POST COMMANDER PRIOR TO SUBMISSION TO THE DEPARTMENT.
