STATE HEADQUARTERS CLOSURE

State Headquarters will be closed on May 27th in observation of Memorial Day.

SPECIAL NOTICE TO DEPARTMENT PROGRAM CHAIRMEN

All Department Program Chairmen are reminded that most Programs ended officially as of April 30, 2024 and you are therefore requested to type up your Program Award Winners; we must have your Award Winners in State Headquarters by no later than Monday, **May 15, 2024** to enable us to order and prepare your Convention Awards in a timely manner. Your cooperation will be greatly appreciated.

PEACE OFFICERS MEMORIAL DAY, MAY 15TH

Posts within the Department of Illinois are hereby instructed to fly their U.S. Flag at "half-staff' on May 15th, 2024 in observance of **Peace Officers Memorial Day, May** 15th as authorized by Public Law 103-122. (See law below):

175. Position and manner of display

The flag, when carried in a procession with another flag or flags, should be either on the marching right; that is, the flag's own right, or, if there is a line of other flags, in front of the center of that line.

(A)-(1) (Unchanged)

(iii) The flag, when flown at half-staff, should be first hoisted to the peak for an instant and then lowered to the half-staff position. The flag should be again raised to the peak before it is lowered for the day. On Memorial Day the flag should be displayed at half- staff until noon only, then raised to the top of the staff. By order of the President, the flag shall be flown at half-staff upon the death of principal figures of the United States Government and the Governor of a State, territory, or possession as a mark of respect to their memory. In the event of the death of other officials or foreign dignitaries, the flag is to be displayed at half-staff according to Presidential instructions or orders, or in accordance with recognized customs or practices not inconsistent with law. In the event of the death of a present or former official of the government of any State, territory, or possession of the United States, that Governor of that State, territory, or possession may proclaim that the National flag shall be flown at half-staff.

The flag shall be flown at half-staff thirty days from the death of a President or a former President, ten days from the day of death of the Vice President, the Chief Justice or a retired Chief Justice of the United States, or the Speaker of the House of Representatives; from the day of death until interment of an Associate Justice of the Supreme Court, a Secretary of an executive or military department, a former Vice President, or the Governor of a State, territory, or possession; and on the day of death.

IMPORTANT - REPORT OF ELECTION FORM

Per section 213 of the National By-laws, Posts that have not submitted a properly completed Post Election Report by June 1 are in arrears and shall be deprived of all representation in District, Department and National conventions. Such representation shall be restored promptly upon proper adjustments of such deficiencies. Posts that have registered delegates for the Department and National Conventions will not receive credentials until the Post has satisfied their arrearage.

SPECIAL NOTICE REGARDING DISTRICT CONVENTIONS

The District Convention is held for the purpose of electing your officers for the upcoming administrative year. Any member, not a member of the District Convention, (Refer to Section 404 of the National By-Laws) may attend the Convention, however, they shall have no voice in business discussions unless requested by the Commander, and shall have no voting privileges. Those on official business shall be recognized by the Commander for the conduct of business. (Article IV, Sec. 403 – Regular, Special and Committee Meetings; Convention; Quorum; Authorized Attendees).

PROOF OF ELIGIBILTY REQUIRED FOR ALL ELECTED AND APPOINTED OFFICERS

Officers shall not be installed or assume the duties of their office until proof of eligibility has been submitted and properly reviewed. Proof of eligibility shall be open to and reviewed by the District Commander, Adjutant and Quartermaster prior to installation to office. In the event an elected or appointed officer fails to submit proof of eligibility within thirty (30) days of election or appointment, any right of the officer to hold the office shall be forfeited, the office declared vacant and the eligibility qualifications of such officer shall be questioned in accordance with the provisions of Section 108 of the National By-Laws. **Proof of Eligibility for District Commanders, District Senior Vice Commanders, and District Junior Vice Commanders MUST** be furnished to the State Adjutant within thirty (30) days of Election.

REMINDER - POST/DISTRICT OFFICER CHANGES OR CORRECTIONS

Please note that changes in Post or District Officers must be reported to State Headquarters immediately. Changes in addresses, phone numbers and e-mail addresses should also be reported immediately – even if changes are made on the Online Membership System (OMS). These changes are not always transmitted to State Headquarters; please help us keep our records current.

DISTRICT ELECTION REPORTS

All District Quartermasters have received a 2024-2025 Report of Election form for the District and they are asked to please submit them as soon as the District election has been held. It is very important that the names, addresses, Post numbers, telephone numbers and e-mail addresses are up-to-date. Commanders-elect who may receive mail at a Post Office Box should also include their street address for shipping purposes.

CREDENTIALS - CONVENTION

Sec. 222 - Delegates, District Convention & Meetings, Department and National Conventions.

- (a) Delegate strength shall be one for every thirty members or fraction thereof in good standing. Delegates and alternates shall be elected in accordance with the Manual of Procedure.
- (b) Delegates elected under this section shall not be considered instructed and may exercise full authority in the duty to be performed.
- (c) Each Post will pay, in accordance with its Department Bylaws, a delegate registration fee for each and every delegate to which the Post shall be entitled (d) Each Post will pay, in advance, a National Convention registration fee of \$25, which shall entite the Post to a packet of onvention information and materials and one identified registered delegate for the National Convention. Each additional delegate attending the National Convention will pay a \$10 delegate fee.

2024-2025 OFFICERS-ELECT

District and Post Officers elected or appointed for the 2024-2025 term are reminded that they will not take office until the Installation of the State Commander on Saturday, June 8, 2024. You are also reminded that the nomination of officers will be held on Friday afternoon, June 7, 2024 with the election and installation of officers taking place on Saturday afternoon, June 8, 2024. DELEGATE REGISTRATION CLOSES AT 10:00 a.m. ON SATURDAY, JUNE 8th. REGISTER EARLY!!

FINAL EXPENSE VOUCHER

Reminder for all Officers who have Expense Accounts – the final date for submitting expense voucher for the 2023-2024 term is **Friday, May 31, 2024**. Expense vouchers must be within budget limitations and must be marked FINAL. **Expense Vouchers received after that date will not be honored**.

Please be sure to have your correct name and title on your report. Your cooperation in this matter will eliminate the chances of errors in the report and will help Department by having information available for the news media, etc.

DEPARTMENT ELECTED/APPOINTED OFFICERS AND DISTRICT JUNIOR VICE COMMANDERS

All newly elected and appointed Department Officers and District Junior Vice Commanders for the 2024-2025 term of office are reminded that according to our National By-Laws all Officers listed above are required to submit proof of eligibility to the Department Adjutant prior to being installed into their respective offices during the State Convention. If you have a question on whether or not you have ever submitted your DD-214 or Proof of Eligibility to the Department, please contact the State Adjutant prior to the convening of the State Convention in June.

DISTRICT CAUCUS DURING STATE CONVENTION

Each District will be responsible for establishing their own District Caucus and it will be their responsibility to contact and invite candidates to address their caucus.

COMMANDERS SPRING MEMBERSHIP CHALLENGE

We are behind on our recruiting goals for this time in the program year. Recruiting is a grassroots effort from the members to ask people to join the VFW or to reinstate their membership in the VFW. We still have a chance to reach our recruiting goals for the year but it is going to take some serious effort. Every member is asked to get at least one new or reinstated member. The VFW meetings will be held in the BOS Center at 1 Convention Center Plaza Springfield, IL 62701, which is located conveniently adjacent to both hotels. The VFW Auxiliary meetings will be held in the President Abe Lincoln Double Tree Hotel. ATTENTION TO EVERYONE PLANNING TO ATTEND STATE CONVENTION

There are detours and traffic pattern changes around the hotels and convention center.

Springfield is part of the high speed rail project. All of the trains in Springfield will eventually be using the tracks on the 10th Street Corridor. Several streets between 9th St and 11th St are currently closed while they build new underpasses, overpasses, and crossings.

If you come into Springfield using Clear Lake Rd, you will have to detour to Carpenter St or Cook St to get around the construction sites.

If you are coming from the North, you can exit on Sangamon Ave (Exit 100) go to Peoria Rd/9th St and go South to convention center and hotels.

If you are coming from the South, you can exit on South Grand (Exit 96) go to 9th St and then North to convention center and hotels.

The other MAJOR change is the change to traffic patterns in downtown Springfield.

For the last 50+ years Springfield has been known for all of its one way streets in downtown Springfield. Starting May 5, 2024, many of those streets will be changed from one way to two way traffic. This include Adams Street which is the street between the 2 hotels and convention center.

This change will be as confusing for local residents as it will be for visitors so stay alert for drivers that may be confused.

STATE CONVENTION REGISTRATION

Included in these General Orders is the Advance Registration Form for the State Convention. Delegates can also be registered online by gong to www.vfwil.org. The registration fee is \$20.00 until May 1st 2024, and will be \$22.00 after May 1st 2024.

Letters of registration confirmation will be mailed to registrants after the proper registration fee has been paid. Registrants will be required to present this confirmation when they check in at the convention registration desk at the BOS Center. Reminder: Delegates will not be allowed to vote until such issues have been resolved; if the Post is in arrears for supplies, poppies or any sort of financial obligation to the Department. The Post must be bonded, inspected, have an election report on file with Department and National Headquarters for the ensuing year, and all audits including the March 31st, 2024 audit must be submitted and approved. HOSPITALITY ROOM

This year the joint hospitality rooms have been moved to President Abe Lincoln Double Tree Hotel, 701 E Adams St, Springfield, IL. This hotel is directly across the street from the Wyndham City Center.

The joint hospitality room will be in the Freeport Room and the Governor Yates Room on 2nd Floor

According to the City Fire Code and the hotel rules, there can be NO heating devices or heating elements in the hospitality room. This includes electric hot plates, crock pots, roasters, and definitely nothing that is gas or propane.

You can have a hot box or thermal insulated container if you want to bring in hot foods in order to keep them warm but nothing that has to be plugged in to keep temperature.

ATTENTION POST COMMANDERS

<u>Under the Department of Illinois Veterans of Foreign Wars By-Laws, Article V</u> - Convention Section 8:

"Each Post shall register, in advance or at the Convention, at least one delegate to the Department Convention by payment of the advance registration fee in effect for such Convention, which fee shall entitle the Post to a packet of convention information and materials. Post failing to comply with this requirement shall be considered delinquent and in arrears.




