IF BONDED OUTSIDE THE V.F.W., you must forward a copy of the fidelity bond to our office as proof that you have met the following requirements pursuant to the National By-Laws and Manual of Procedure which states: **Sec. 709-Bonds – Each officer accountable for funds or property pursuant to any provision of the By-Laws shall be bonded with an indemnity company as surety in a sum at least equal to the amount of the liquid assets for which, so far as can be anticipated, he/she may be accountable.**

NOTE: a “Crime” policy does not meet the above requirements.

If more than \$15,000.00 is needed to cover your Posts liquid assets, the fee is \$50.00 for the first \$15,000.00 and \$5.00 per \$1,000.00 for everything over \$15,000.00 (See breakdown below)
